Fee Waiver Scholarship Informational Guidelines/Agreement

The Fee Waiver Scholarship is a partial tuition waiver scholarship. Continuing and transfer students who have accumulated a minimum of 12 credits in MCCD courses numbered 100 or above (Pass/Fail credits excluded), and who have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 may apply for the Honors Fee Waiver Scholarship. New Fee Waiver candidates are required to submit an application and essay to the Honors Program Assistant or Coordinator by the posted due date. Students who are accepted will receive partial tuition fee waivers (refunds) based on the number of credits for which they are enrolled (see following breakdown).

Please note: State law now requires that a person who is not a citizen or legal resident of the United States or who is without lawful immigration status is not entitled to classification as an in-state student pursuant to A.R.S. Section 15-1802 or entitled to classification as a county resident pursuant to A.R.S. 15-1902-01. According to state law, a person who is not a citizen of the United States, who is without lawful immigration status, and who is enrolled at any community college under the jurisdiction of an Arizona community college district is not entitled to tuition waivers, fee waivers, grants, scholarship assistance, financial aid, tuition assistance or any other type of financial assistance that is subsidized or paid in whole or in part with state monies.

Acceptance (Students applying for the CGCC Fee Waiver Scholarship must meet all of the following eligibility requirements to receive the scholarship):

- *Be a citizen or legal resident of the United States.
- *Completed a minimum of 12 credits in MCCD courses numbered 100 or above (Pass/Fail credits excluded).
- *Have a cumulative GPA of 3.25.

Requirements, Retention, and Renewal:

Students who are accepted into the Honors Fee Waiver program must meet the following requirements:

- *Enroll in and complete the number of credits (Pass/Fail excluded) for which a partial fee waiver has been awarded for (a minimum of 3 or more Honors credit hours each semester).
- *Enroll in and complete an Honors Option course and contract as required by the program each semester.
- * Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or higher each semester. All MCCD coursework completed (including Dual Enrollment) is included in the cumulative GPA.
- * Must receive a "C" or higher in your Honors class each semester.

Termination:

Fee Waiver Scholars whose cumulative GPA falls below 3.25 will not continue to receive the award, but may reapply for the scholarship once their GPA is again 3.25 or above. Any grade of Incomplete will cause a student to be put on probation until the Incomplete grade is made up.

Honors Program Graduation:

- * Complete a minimum of 15 Honors credits (Pass/Fail excluded).
- * Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- *Petition for Graduation in the Advisement Department (see appropriate class schedule for deadlines).

Important Notes:

Periodically during the semester, the student's enrollment is reviewed. If the student is enrolled in less than 12 credit hours or not in an Honors class, the scholarship is cancelled and the student is responsible for all fees. Honors Program students should not withdraw from courses without first consulting with the Honors Department.
