**Honors Achievement Award Informational Guidelines/Agreement**

The Honors Achievement Award is a partial tuition waiver scholarship. Continuing and transfer students who have accumulated a minimum of 12 credits in MCCCDC courses numbered 100 or above (Pass/Fail credits excluded), and who have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 may apply for the Honors Achievement Award Scholarship. New scholarship candidates are required to submit an application to the Honors Program Assistant or Coordinator by the posted due date. Students who are accepted will receive partial tuition fee waivers (refunds) based on the number of credits for which they are enrolled (see following breakdown).

**Please note: Only those with a lawful presence in the US may qualify for MCCCDC scholarships or federal financial aid. Any information you provide about your legal status when you apply for financial aid or scholarships may be subject to mandatory reporting to federal immigration authorities under Arizona law.**

**I have read the Presidents' Scholarship Agreement (page 2) and made a copy for my personal files. I understand that failure to comply with these requirements will result in the loss of my scholarship, which cannot be reinstated.**

Acceptance (Students applying for the CGCC Honors Achievement Award must meet all of the following eligibility requirements to receive the scholarship):

- \*Be a citizen or legal resident of the United States.
- \*Completed a minimum of 12 credits in MCCCDC courses numbered 100 or above (Pass/Fail credits excluded).
- \*Have a cumulative GPA of 3.25.

**Requirements, Retention, and Renewal:**

Students who are accepted into the Honors Achievement program must meet the following requirements:

- \*Enroll in and complete the number of credits (Pass/Fail excluded) for which a partial fee waiver has been awarded for (a minimum of 3 or more Honors credit hours each semester).
- \*Enroll in and complete an Honors Option course and contract as required by the program each semester.
- \* Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or higher each semester. All MCCCDC coursework completed (including Dual Enrollment) is included in the cumulative GPA.
- \* Must receive a "C" or higher in your Honors class each semester.

**Termination:**

Honors Achievement Scholars whose cumulative GPA falls below 3.25 will not continue to receive the award, but may reapply for the scholarship once their GPA is again 3.25 or above. Any grade of Incomplete will cause a student to be put on probation until the Incomplete grade is made up.

**Honors Program Graduation:**

- \* Complete a minimum of 15 Honors credits (Pass/Fail excluded) and participate in 10 hours service learning.
- \* Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- \*Petition for Graduation in the Advisement Department (see appropriate class schedule for deadlines).

**Important Notes:**

Periodically during the semester, the student's enrollment is reviewed. If the student is enrolled in less than the amount of credit hours funded or not in an Honors class, the student is responsible to pay back the award and fees or future scholarship funds are canceled. After meeting with the Honors Advisor, it is the student's responsibility to be in compliance with the honors guidelines. Honors Program students should not withdraw from courses without first consulting with the Honors Advisor or Honors Coordinators.

**APPLICATION CHECK LIST**

Complete steps 1 and 2 to begin your application process.

1. Review the eligibility requirements of the Honors Achievement Scholarship Agreement.  
Read carefully: Acceptance and Renewal and Retention sections.

**Please Note:** State law now requires that a person who is not a citizen or legal resident of the United States or who is without lawful immigration status is not entitled to classification as an in-state student pursuant to A.R.S. Section 15-1802 or entitled to classification as a county resident pursuant to A.R.S. Section 15-1802.01.

According to state law, a person who is not a citizen of the United States, who is without lawful immigration status, and who is enrolled at any community college under the jurisdiction of an Arizona community college district is not entitled to tuition waivers, fee waivers, grants, scholarship assistance, financial aid, tuition assistance or any other type of financial assistance that is subsidized or paid in whole or in part with state monies.

2. Complete and submit the following documents to the college that you plan to attend:

- \_\_\_ a. Honors Achievement Scholarship Application. Type or print legibly.
- \_\_\_ b. Maricopa Community College District placement test scores in English, reading, and mathematics.
- \_\_\_ c. A copy of one of the following 12 documents:
  1. An Arizona driver license issued after 1996 or an Arizona non-operating identification license.
  2. A birth certificate or delayed birth certificate issued in any state, territory or possession of the United States.
  3. A United States certificate of birth abroad.
  4. A United States passport.
  5. A foreign passport with a United States visa.
  6. An I-94 form with a photograph.
  7. A United States citizenship and immigration services employment authorization document or refugee travel document.
  8. A United States certificate of naturalization.
  9. A United States certificate of citizenship.
  10. A tribal certificate of Indian blood.
  11. A tribal or bureau of Indian affairs affidavit of birth.
  12. Tribal members, the elderly and "persons with disabilities or incapacity of the mind or body," may submit certain types of documentation under Section 1903 of the federal Social Security Act (42 United States Code §1396b, as amended by Section 6036 of the federal Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 ).
