The Dietetic Technology program is an AAS degree emphasizing medical nutrition therapy and food service management. Students acquire the knowledge and skills foundation to work in dietetics through the integration of classroom learning and 466 hours of supervised practice. Emphasis is placed on the development of communication and human relations techniques that prepare the graduate for professional success. Upon successful completion of the program, the graduate will be eligible to take the registration examination of the Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR) in order to become a Dietetic Technician, Registered (DTR).

PROGRAM PREREQUISITES:

1. CPR/AED Certification for Health Care Providers must be completed prior to registering taking FON practicum courses.
2. If taking BIO201 & 202 vs BIO160, then the prerequisite is "BIO156 or BIO181 with a grade of "C" or better, or one year high school biology course with a grade of "C" or better, or CHM130 or higher numbered CHM prefixed course, or one year of high school chemistry suggested but not required."
