- Make reports at Faculty Association meetings and at Division Meetings
- Recommend faculty and staff development ideas -- liaise with Faculty Development Team
- Share 'best practices' with each other
- Oversee assessment instruments and data collection
- Liaise with Institutional Research Office
- Maintain an adequate budget for assessment activities
- Create and maintain a web page
