Services provided:

- **Student Support Services** provides academic and personal intervention and support for CGCC's diverse student population. Services may include: individual or group support, crisis management, short-term intervention, personal and skill development, campus and community referrals and resources.
- **Early Alert Retention and Success Program** is a voluntary student focused retention and success program designed for faculty and staff to identify those students who may be struggling academically, personally and could benefit from early detection, intervention, support and resources.
- **Disability Resources and Services (DRS)** provides access, advocacy and support for students who have a documented disability according to The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Amendment Act of 2008, and section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act. Students must identify their disability, register, and follow all DRS procedures in order to obtain services.

Student Success Programs:

- **DRS Peer Mentoring Support** (pilot) is a volunteer student initiative to assist and support DRS students with their academic goals, and provide connection to the college environment.
- **DRS Support and Training:** "Getting' in the Groove", and Navigating Success
- **Advocacy and Training:** for specialized interests groups
